
Elks Drug Awareness Program

The Elks Drug Awareness Program is proud of our partnerships with the Drug Enforcement Administration, ONDCP, Drug Free America, CADCA, Marvel Comics, and many other private and public institutions who are all dedicated to eliminate illegal drugs from our country. The Elks Drug Awareness Program is proud to have a special ambassador working for the Drug Awareness Program that used to work in the White House. His name is Henry Lozano.



Every year, the Elks' Drug Awareness Program hands out more than 6 million pieces of antidrug material, P.S.A.'s, teaching aids, and training programs at no cost to communities, and to our partnering coalitions.





Essay Contest, Poster Contest, Red Ribbon Week

The Elks Drug Awareness Programs helps to get youth, parents, and their community involved, though Essay Contest, Poster Contest, Red Ribbon Week, Hands Across the Border, Enrique Camerena Award Program, and the President volunteer Service Award. The Elks sponsors seminars, workshops and drug-free functions.

Essay and Poster Contest

- Involve children, schools and parents in the Drug Awareness Program
- Create an opportunity for States to gain National recognition
- Great publicity for local Lodges & State Associations

Who can Participate in the Essay Contest?

- Each State gets to pick who they want to participate
- Ideally this contest is for boys and girls in grades 6 - 8 (<u>states may broaden</u> <u>participating grades if they wish</u>)
- This is not a contest for High School Students!

When Does the Contest Run?

- This contest runs from July 1, 2015 until April 1, 2016
- Each State determines when the contest will be held (winter months are good)
- Each State will determine when the Essays need to be in the hands of the State Chairman (give yourself some time)

What Size Should the Essay Be?

- ▶ The Essay should be written on 8-1/2 by 11 paper
- The Essay should be no more than 200 words in length
- Handwritten Essays are preferred, but an entry is <u>not required</u> to be handwritten

What Is Needed Beside Essay?

- In addition to the Essay itself the following information is needed:
 - * Name of the Student
 - * Age of the Student
 - * Grade of the Student
 - * Home Address of the Student
 - * Name of the Student's School

Additional Information Needed

- * Location of School and Grade
- * Name & Number of sponsoring Elks Lodge
- * Students should be informed that their Essays become the Property of the BPOE and may not be returned

- This is not a contest for High School Students!

What Size Should the Poster Be?

- ▶ The Poster should be drawn on 8-1/2 by 11 paper
- The Poster should contain an anti-drug use message
- The Poster should not contain characters or items that are Trade Marked

What Is Needed Beside Poster?

- In addition to the Poster itself the following information is needed:
 - * Name of the Student
 - * Age of the Student
 - * Grade of the Student
 - * Home Address of the Student
 - * Name of the Student's School

Additional Information Needed

- * Location of School and Grade
- * Name & Number of sponsoring Elks Lodge
- * Students should be informed that their Posters become the Property of the BPOE and may not be returned



When Does the Contest Run?

- This contest runs from July 1, 2014 until June 30, 2015
- Each State determines when the contest will be held (winter months are good)
- Each State will determine when the Posters need to be in the hands of the State Chairman (give yourself some time)

Each State winner will <u>eventually*</u> make its way into a new edition of the Coloring Book.

* "Eventually" because there are only 20 pages in the Coloring Book!

Where Do My Prizes Come From?

- Your prizes come from you and your state
- Prizes take whatever form you want (certificate; savings bond; bicycle etc.)
- There will be one National winner who will receive an electronic media device from the Drug Awareness Program (value = \$300)

The Elks Enrique Camarena Award

The Elks Enrique Camarena Award was established by the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks to recognize and honor law enforcement officers who have made a significant contribution in the field of drug prevention and who personify Agent Camarena's belief that one person can make a difference.

Comic Book Program

Elks Drug Awareness Program has teamed up with Marvel Comics to produce an Action Comic Book featuring Spider Man, Fantastic Four, and Elroy the Elk. The goal of this program is to help educate school children in the 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grades about the dangers of underage drinking and negative peer pressures. The program includes the comic books, teachers' guide, and posters.



Public Service Announcements

- Drug Awareness Program developed a set of Public Service Announcements on Marijuana, Methamphetamines, Parenting, Underage Drinking, and Underage Tobacco use.
- The Elks National Drug Awareness Program offers 30 sec., public service announcements that cover a wide range of topics. These PSA are available at no cost to State, District, and Lodges Chairs.

Drug Awareness Trailers

Our Drug Awareness Program trailers have participated in 1,006 events this year, and traveled in excess of 206,840 miles. All trailers are "manned" by Elk volunteers. The Elks Drug Education Trailers contain Information from videos, posters, pamphlets, coloring books, fatal vision goggles, and promotional items being provided free.

Elroy, The Elk Costume – Elroy T. Elk is the official DAP mascot. He has appeared in many school programs, usually travels with our trailers, and participates in all of our youth programs.
